

Measures Taken In Avoidance Of Damage (Sue and Labour):-

The insurer will pay costs incurred by the insured in taking reasonable but exceptional measures to avoid or mitigate impending Damage insured provided that

- i) The impending Damage does not stem from any reasonably foreseeable cause and that damage would be the natural outcome to be expected in the absence of such measures.
- ii) The insurer is satisfied that Damage has been avoided or reduced in consequence of the measures taken.
- iii) The terms exclusions and conditions of this extension shall apply as if loss or Damage had occurred.
